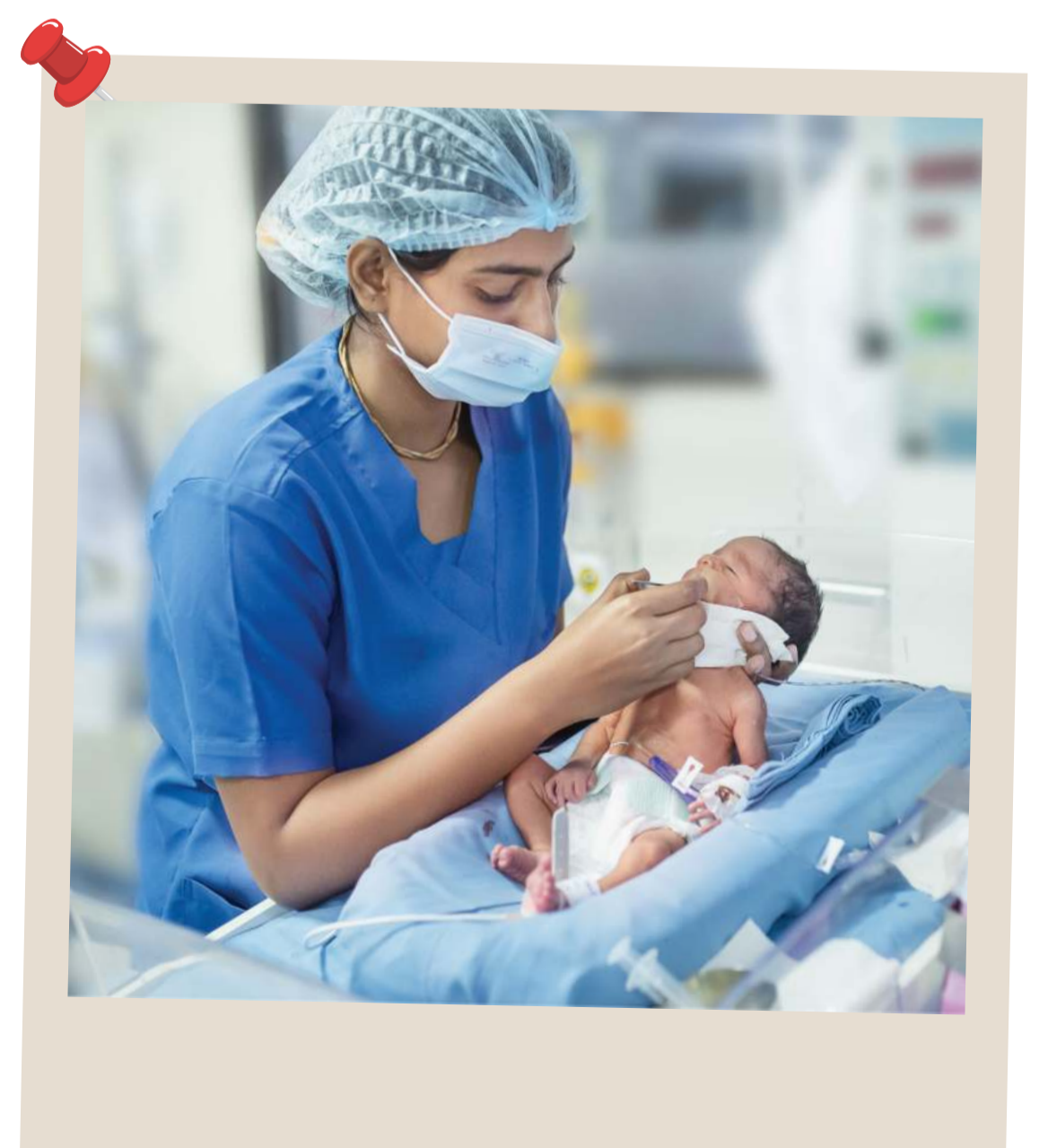
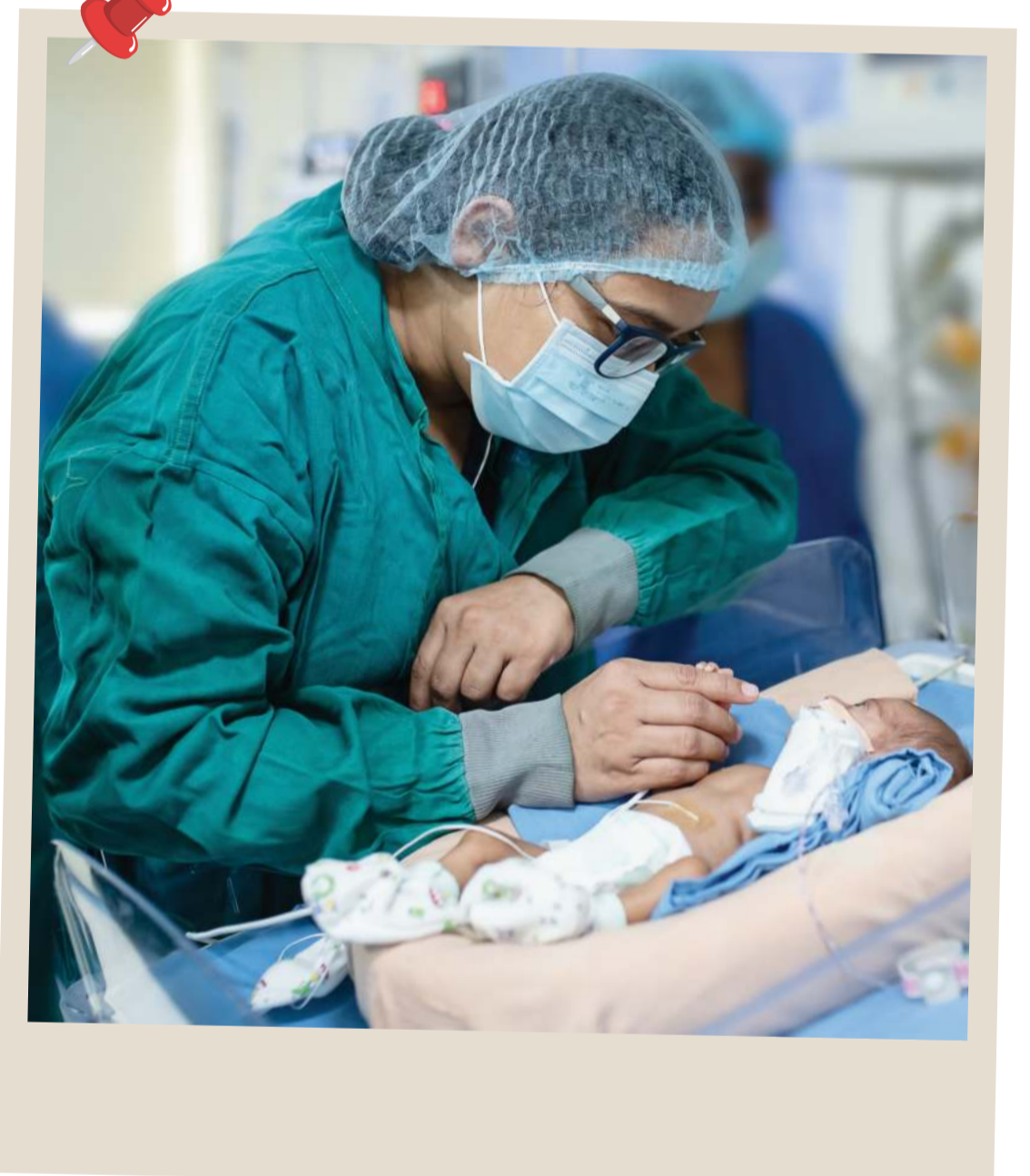
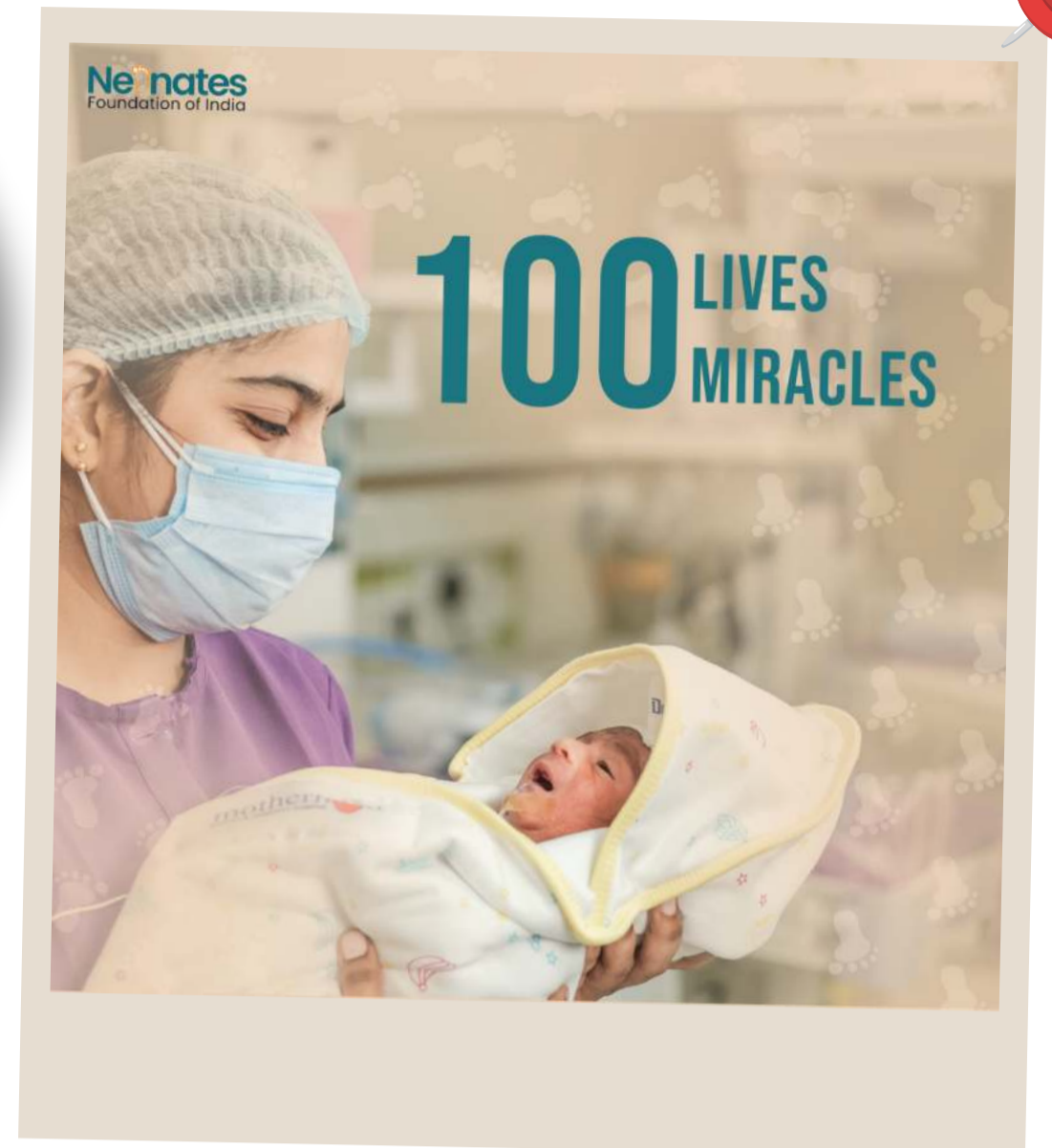

A SPOTLIGHT OF COURAGE: BABY OF HEMAVATHI AND MANJUNATH

Hemavathi and Manjunath, a couple who lost their first child to preterm delivery, faced years of grief and uncertainty.

After 11 years of marriage, they were blessed with another pregnancy but were filled with fear. Their baby girl was born prematurely at 32 weeks, weighing 1.25 kg, and required NICU care for conditions including perinatal asphyxia and Respiratory Distress Syndrome (RDS).

While Manjunath being a daily wage labour and Hemavathi a homemaker, finances were a major concern. Thankfully, Aditi Hospital connected them to NFI, which provided the much-needed financial support.

Today, their daughter is home, thriving, and a symbol of hope and resilience. The family remains deeply grateful to NFI for their assistance.

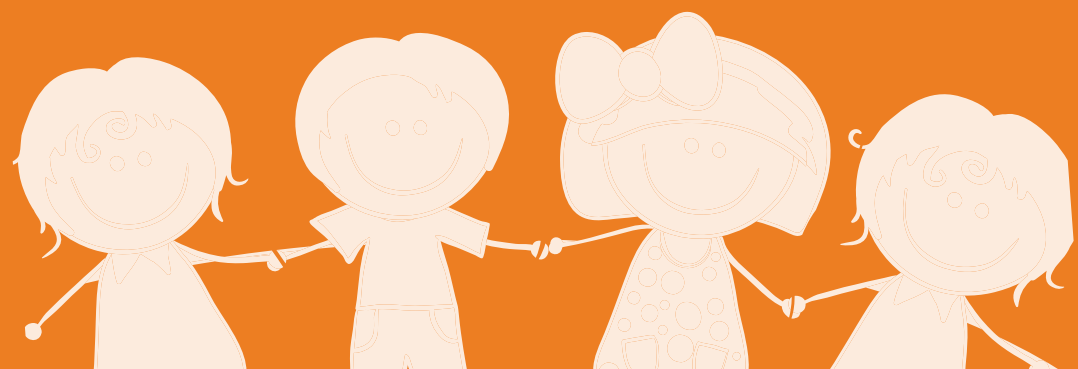
CHILDREN FOR NFI
