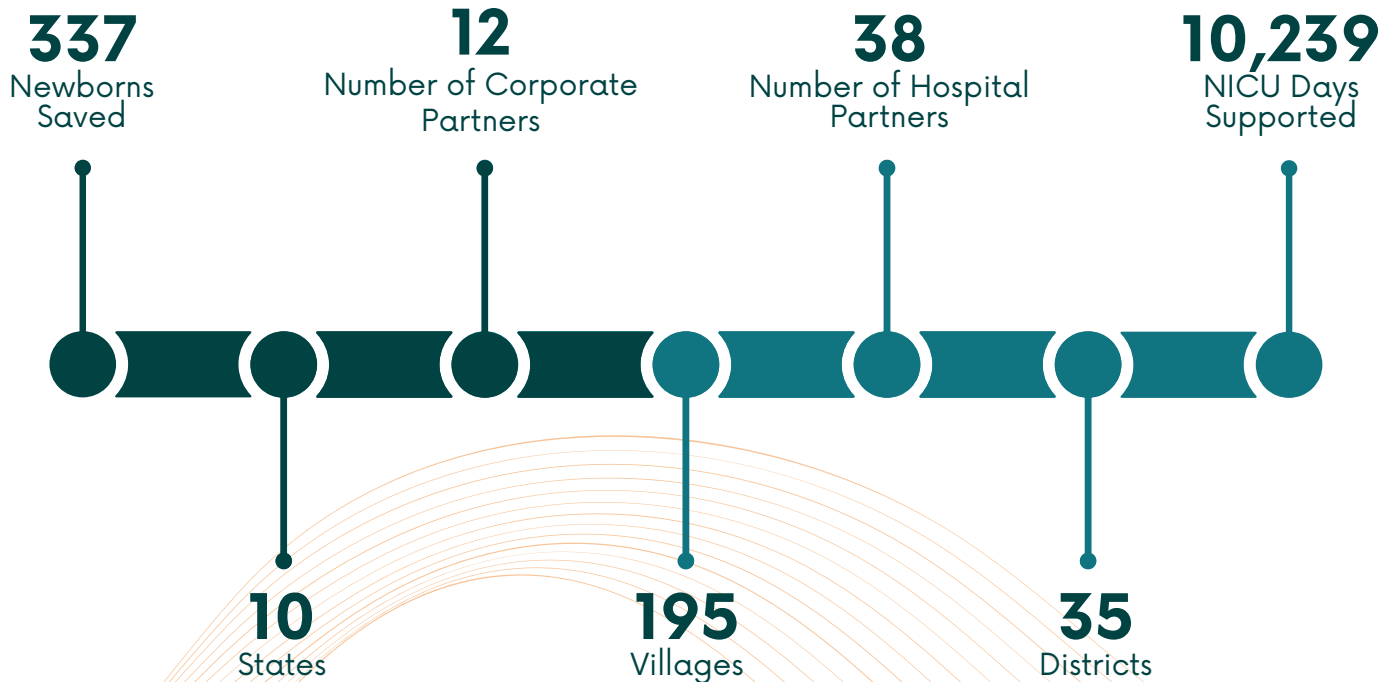
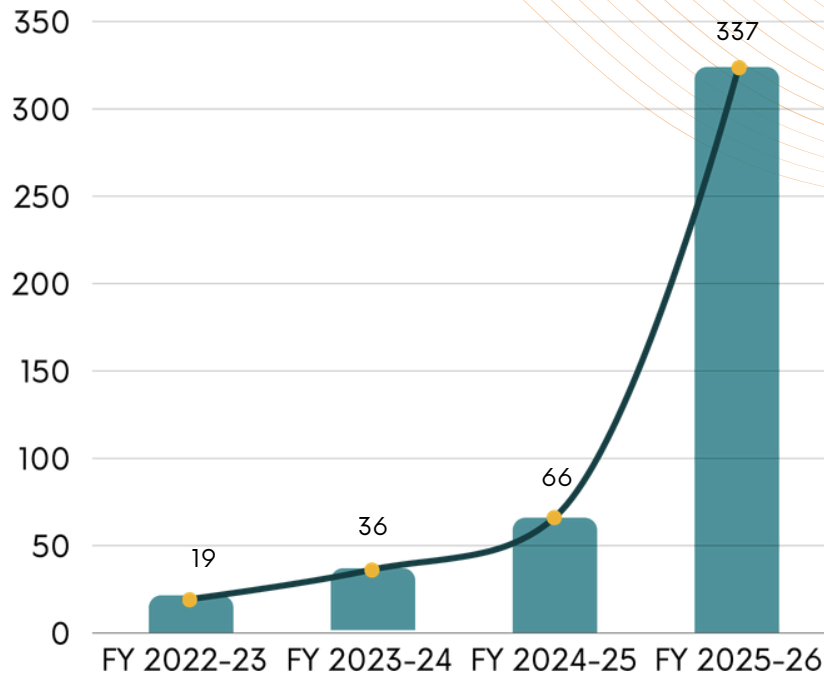

Our Impact Over the Year



No. of Newborns Saved



Tata Mumbai Marathon

₹12,01,202 raised. | 90 runners.

Every stride supported life-saving NICU care and intensive monitoring for critically ill newborns from underserved families.



100 Babies Saved | Maharashtra

4,037 NICU bed days enabled.

These babies were extremely high-risk, with a median gestational age of 32 weeks, and the smallest weighed just 0.66 kg at birth.

17% were born before 28 weeks, and nearly 15% were extremely low birth weight (<1 kg).

NFI's support made timely care possible.

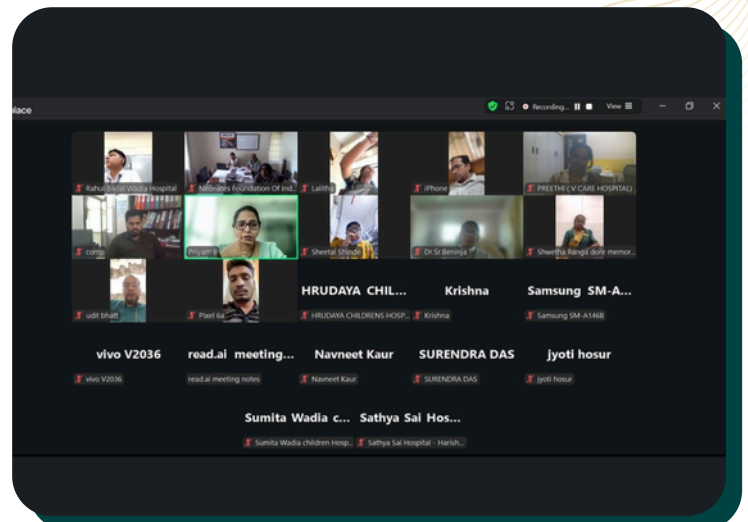

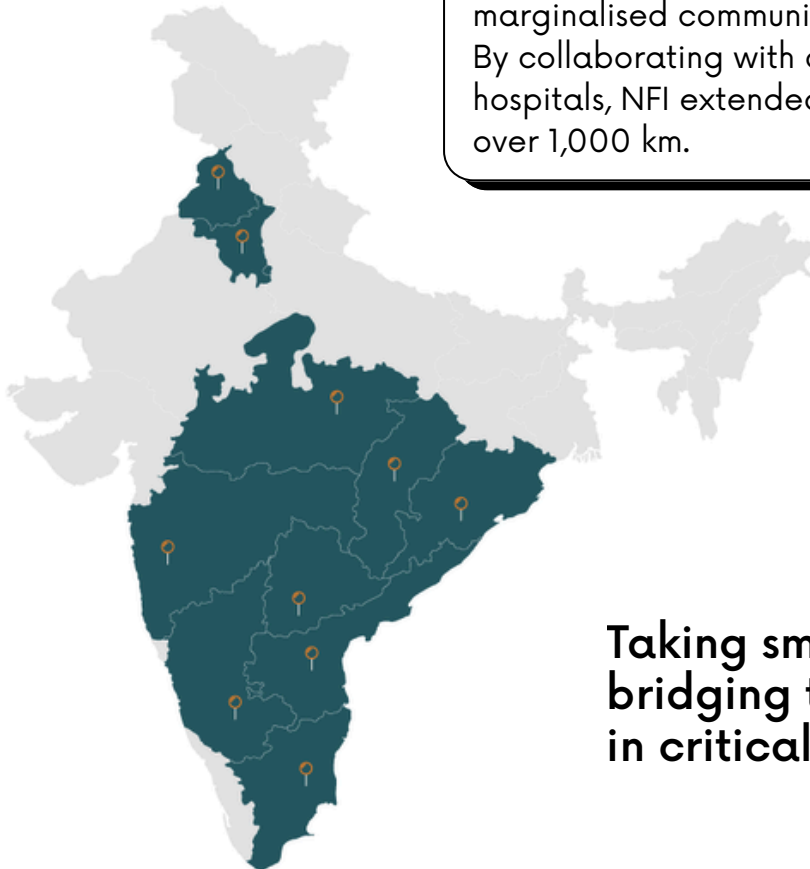
